REPORT ON ACTIVITIES OF NSS IN 2017-18

The NSS unit of Government V. Y. T. PG Autonomous College Durg, has extensively taken part in Swachh Bharat Abhiyan besides it's normal activities in session 2017-2018 has organized several programmes.

Aim and Objective-

The aim and objective were to create awareness among students as well as citizens about cleanliness of the surroundings.

Action Taken- To full fill the aim and objectives our NSS team had organised following programs.

1. Annual Camp- In 2017-18, the annual Camp of NSS was organised in village Samoda, nearly 24 kilometers away from college campus for seven days, between 10-01-2018 to 16-01-2018. Total 108 students, besides NSS officers and college staffs have stayed there to seven days and serve village with following activities

- Performed survey of village women for standard use sanitary pads
- Filled all points in village having probability of water logging
- Organised sickle cell anaemia testing camp and eye checking camp.

2. On 31-10-2017 the unit has organised a rally of NSS cadets along with programmes officer with banner, poster and slogan and marched across Rajendra Park Durg to Patel Chowk Durg. After rally all NSS members have organised a symposia and discussed about need and significance of cleanliness. Another significant outcome was the symposia has expressed message of unity of society,

irrespective of caste, creed of religion.
