

Under the guidance and supervision of Principal Dr. R.N.Singh and Professor-in-Charge Dr. Tarlochan Kaur Sandhu, a large number of Youth Red Cross volunteers of Government VYT PG Autonomous College, Durg, took initiative to tackle and fight Covid-19 Pandemic in Durg and Bhilai regions through various activities during the lockdown. Following are the activities listed below:

- ➤ In the initial phase of the outbreak of Corona Virus the volunteers of Youth Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club conducted awareness campaigns to sensitize the locals, making them familiar as to what Corona Virus is, as an information to the community and prepare them to control its infection by explaining the symptoms.





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
