



**Subject Popularization Program**  
**(Extension Activity) (22.01.2018)**

The faculty members and PG students of department of Microbiology visited Govt. H.S. School Urla (Durg) on 22.01.2018 under the banner of Microbiology Association. The program was preliminarily aimed to provide acquaintance with the Microbiology as a subject to the students and to extend the knowledge to society.

The programme was volunteered by 44 students of M.Sc. (Microbiology). A presentation focused on scope and importance of Microbiology as a subject of higher education was delivered by Head, Dr. Pragya Kulkarni. The PG students prepared posters on prevailing infectious diseases, causal organisms and prevention measures for demonstration and easy understanding. All the posters were then donated to the school authority for future use. The blood samples of school students were taken with the help of paramedical staff and their blood groups were identified. The blood group cards were given to respective students with some tips on common and un-common types of blood groups and required precautions.

All together 127 school students benefitted with the knowledge of their blood groups. The school students eagerly asked questions about the future prospects.
