Real Life conversation practice: Greeting and leave-taking; Introducing Oneself; Invitation; Making Requests; Expressing Gratitude; Complimenting and Congratulating; Expressing Sympathy; Apologizing; Asking for Information; Seeking permission; Complaining and Expressing Regret
