- 4- To develop understanding and use of comparative study and analysis.
- 5- To provide adequate and analytical knowledge of theory and behaviour in international politics.
- 6- To develop a comprehensive understanding about Public administration , administrative system, local governments and decentralisation .
- 7- To provide latest know-how about research methodologies and research tools .
- 8- To cater the requirement of civil service and NET syllabus for students.

EMPLOYABILITY OF THE PROGRAMME

- Presented syllabus includes constitution, polity, national movement, democratic process, decentralisation and local self government, party system, administrative system, state politics, international relation , most of them are integral part of general studies paper of any national and state competitive exams for recruitment . Hence the course is relevant and useful for competitive exams .
- Political science is available as an optional subject in IAS and state Public Service Commissions and has a good record of success . Thus it is useful for civil service as well .

1. Questions from question number 1 and question number 2 will be compulsory.
2. Question number 3 and question number 4 will have internal choice (two optional) out of which one has to be solved.
3. Two compulsory very short answer type questions (2+2 marks), one internal choice short answer question (4 marks) and one internal choice long answer question (12 marks) will be asked from each unit as above. In this way, there will be 20 marks from each unit and a total 80 marks from four units of the syllabus.
4. The Internal Assessment Test will be as follows.
 - A. Internal Screening Test 20 marks in each question paper.
 - B. Power point presentation under seminar in any one question paper 20 marks
 - C. Assignment 20 marks each in all the papers except the seminar paper.
 - D. The internal assessment test + seminar in any question paper and internal examination test + assignment in the remaining question papers will be considered after calculating the average of the candidate's score.

4. Seminars and PowerPoint Presentations - For seminar and power point presentation seminar, there will be rotation in the selection of question papers from

the power point presentation session 2021-22. That is, in this session 2021-22, the first question paper in the first semester, the second question paper in the second semester, the third question paper in the third semester, the fourth question paper in the fourth semester, followed by power point presentations on the question papers in increasing order from the next session. The presentation will be prepared and prepared under the direction of the Asst. professor./ Professor

5. In the fourth semester, the fifth paper will be a short research dissertation which will be of 100 marks. 80 marks will be for research work and 20 marks for oral tests .






