

Inauguration of English Literary Association
Date : 25.11.2022

The English Literary Association was formed by the Department of English on 25.11.22. The inaugural function was graced by Dr. Kaustubh Ranjan, Assistant Professor, Department of English, IKSVM, Khairagarh.

The objective behind the formation of the association was to provide a platform to the students of the department to inculcate and develop literary and aesthetic sense, shun up their inhibitions and exhibit their talents.

The event started by paying obeisance and flowers to the Goddess of Knowledge Maa Saraswati. The Head of the Department, Dr. Qamar Talat, welcomed the chief guest, Dr. Kaustubh Ranjan, announced the names of the office bearers and conducted the Oath Taking Ceremony. Kaleshwar Kumar, Avitesh Kumar of Sem III, Ms. Alka Banjarey and Ankita Rodha of Sem I were nominated as President, Vice-President, Secretary and Joint Secretary respectively. Under the auspices of the English Literary Association, a guest lecture was organized on the occasion. Ms. Diya Subba, student of MA. SEM I introduced Dr. Ranjan to the audience and also threw light on the topic of the talk **Post Colonial Studies with special reference to Orientalism and Feminism.**

Dr. Ranjan began his discourse by defining **Pre Colonialism, Colonialism and Post-Colonialism.** He elaborated his talk by citing examples of political, cultural, religious and linguistic interventions of the British empire. Elaborating upon the Representation and Misrepresentation of the natives by the colonizers he quoted excerpts from Heart of Darkness by Joseph Conrad and Things Fall Apart by Achebe. During the discourse he highlighted the terms associated with Colonial and Post Colonial literatures.

Discoursing upon **Feminism and Feminist Writings** he talked of **White Feminism, Black Feminism, Dalit Feminism and Politics of Gender.**

The discourse ended with an active question and answer session. The PG students and the students of UG literature were greatly benefitted by this event.

In this event the students of MA SEM III - Ms. Ritu Gatre, Ms. Rafeia Zareen Khan, Manoj Paikra and Avitesh recited soulful self composed poems. The event was conducted by Manoj Paikra and vote of thanks was extended by Ms. Pooja Vishwakarma. The faculty members Dr. Somali Gupta, Dr. Suchitra Gupta, Dr. Mercy George, Dr. Nigar Ahmed, Dr. Meena Maan and Dr. Tarlochan Kaur provided whole hearted support to make the event successful.

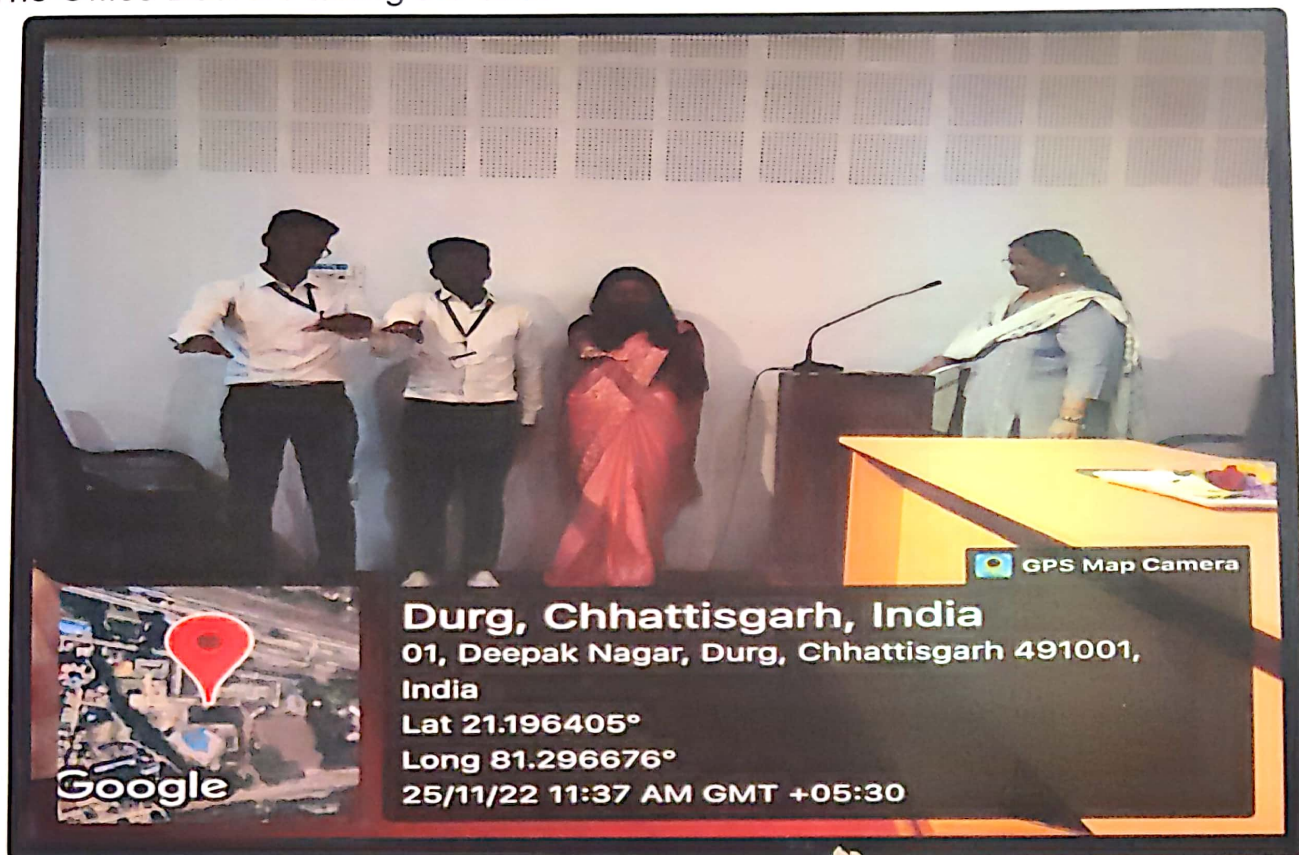
