

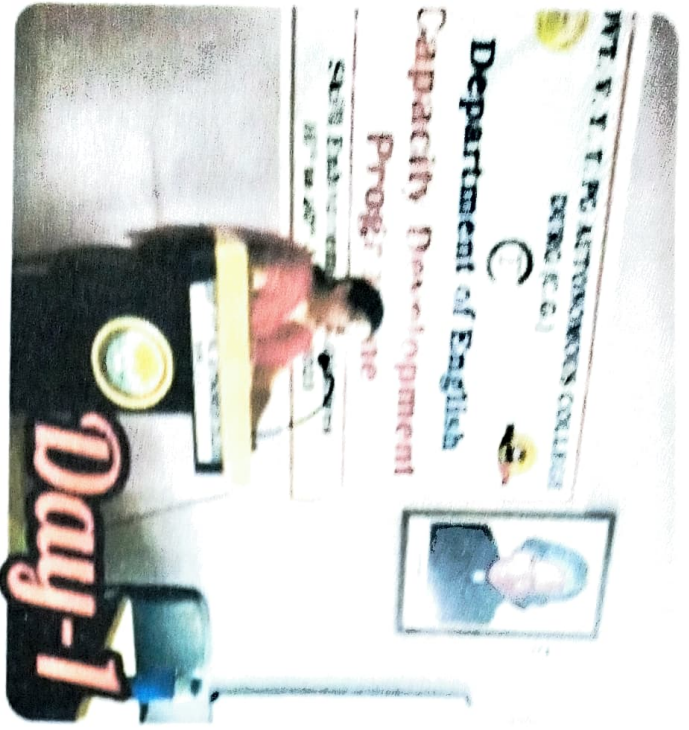
how self-confidence can make a better person. Dr Nigar Ahmed spoke on how grooming and etiquette are important in life.

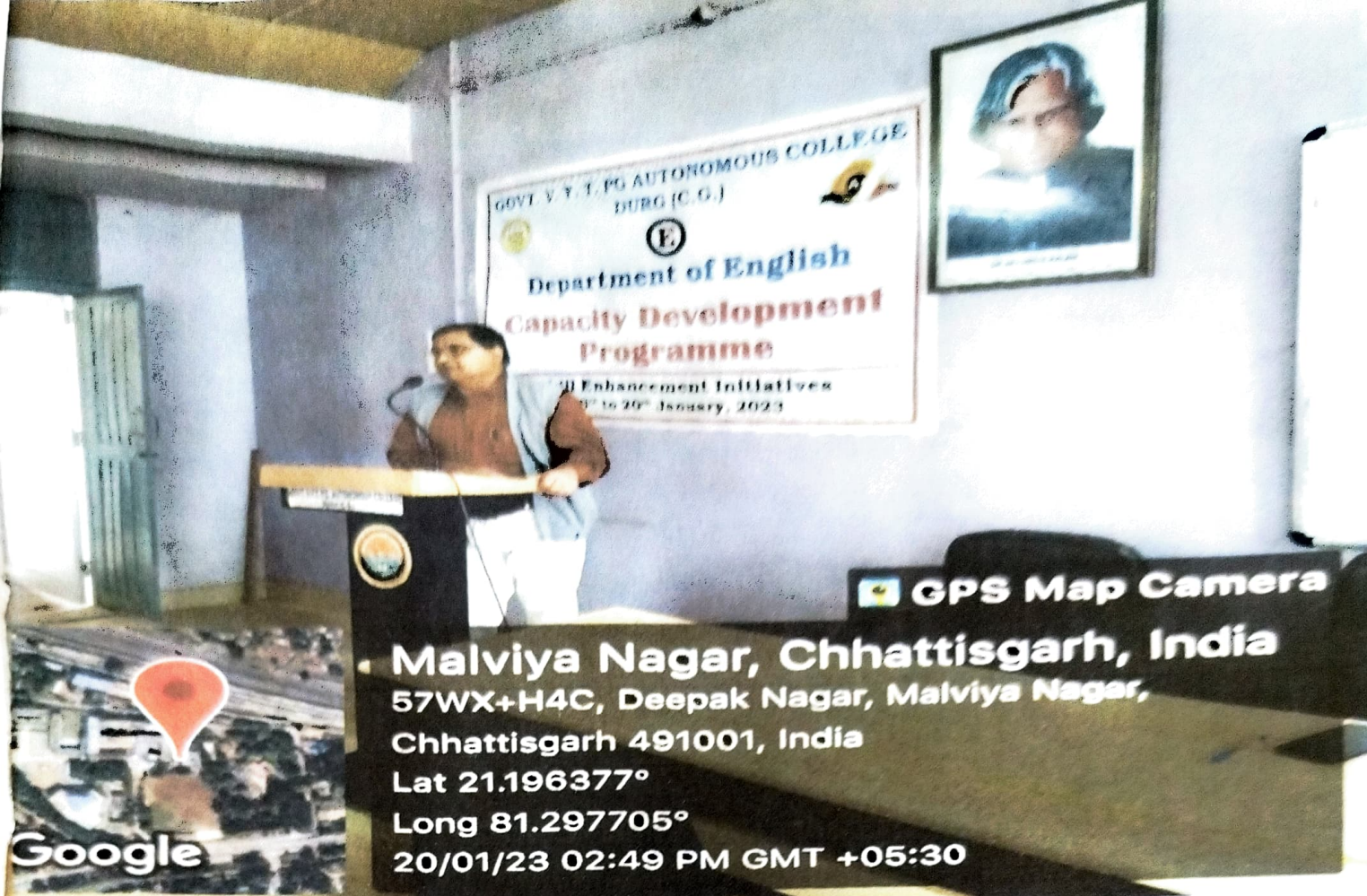

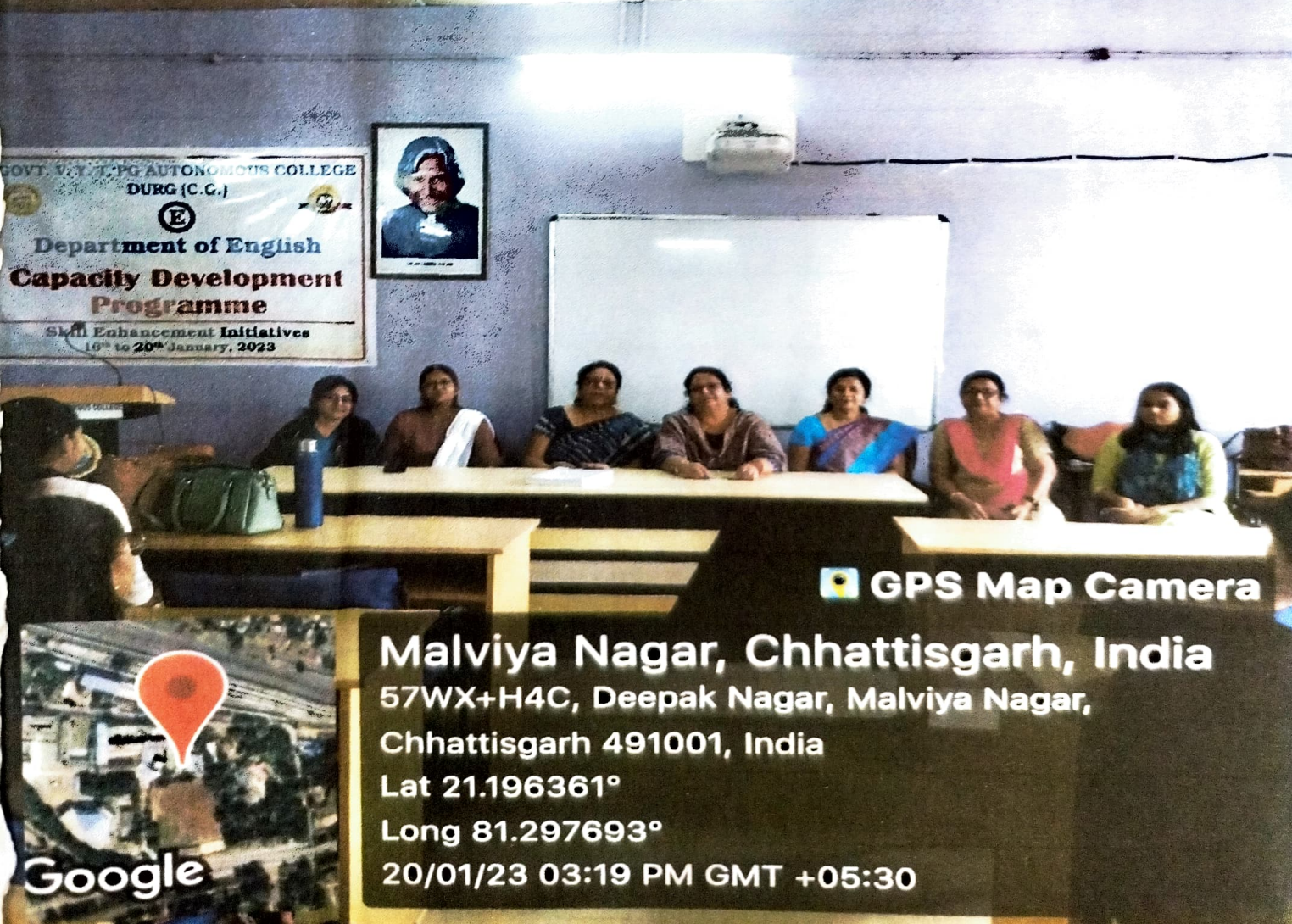
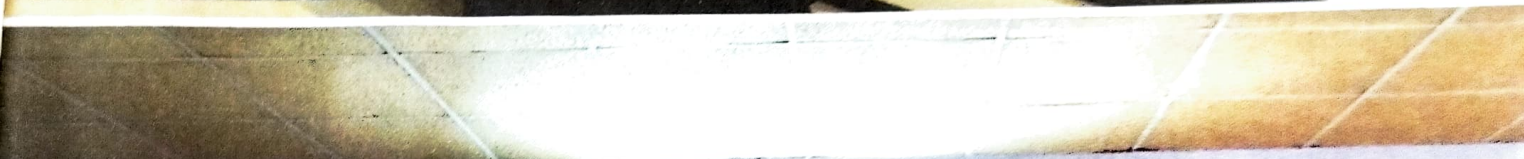
