### Session 2023-24

With a focus on quality enhancement, the IQAC of the institution has established a comprehensive feedback mechanism, starting with the collection of feedback from various stakeholders through a structured rating-based form, aimed at continuously improving the curriculum. The College is committed to providing an exceptional learning environment that enables students to reach their full potential. Feedback from faculty contributes significantly to enhancing teaching and learning practices, fostering a deeper understanding of the subject matter. Additionally, faculty members serving as Deans and subject experts on the Boards of Studies at the University and other autonomous colleges offer valuable insights and recommendations for further curriculum development.

### Meth<mark>odology</mark>:

The feedback from teachers on curricular aspects was gathered using a structured questionnaire containing 10 questions that addressed various components of the curriculum, along with space for suggestions on potential improvements. A five-point Likert scale was employed to rate responses, with the following levels of agreement assigned numerical values:

### 1- Strongly Disagree; 2- Disagree; 3- Neutral; 4- Agree; 5- Strongly Agree

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels Therefore, Range= (5-1)/5=4/5=0.8 Hence, Range for:


### Data Analysis and Interpretation:




















