Inanimate objects are classified scientifically into three major categories—those that breakdown, those that get lost, and those that don't work. The goal of all inanimate objects is to resist man and ultimately to defeat him, and the three major classifications are based on the method each object uses to achieve its purpose. As a general rule, any object capable of breaking down at the moment when it is most needed will do so. The automobile is typical of the category. With the cunning peculiar to its breed. the automobile never breaks down while entering a filling station which has a large staff of idle mechanics. It waits until it reaches a downtown intersection in the middle of the rush hour or until it is fully loaded with family and luggage on the Ohio Turnpike. Thus, it creates maximum inconvenience, frustration, irritability, thereby reducing its owner's lifespan. Washing machines, garbage disposals, lawn mowers, furnaces, T.V. sets, tape recorders, slide projectors are in league with the automobile to take their turn at breaking down whenever life threatens to flow smoothly for their enemies.
