

## Scale: 1. Strongly Agree 2. Agree 3. Neither Agree nor Disagree 4. Disagree 5. Strongly Disagree



#### IQAC Analysis of Students' Feedback on Curriculum:






#### Q.1 Relevance of Curriculum: The content is adequate and career oriented




About Relevance of the Curriculum, 96% of the students strongly agreed and 1% are of the opinion that some changes are needed to make it more relevant.

#### Q. 2 Coverage of Course: The course includes fundamental and applied aspect




Regarding coverage of the course 97% students were of the opinion that course is completed in the class where as 1% believe that whole course is not completed in some classes.




#### Q. 3 Value addition: The curriculum incorporates environmental, moral and social values.


About Value Addition, 92% students strongly agreed but 7% students seek changes and introduction of such courses and changes in the curriculum to make it more employability.

Q. 4 Skill development: The curriculum is supported with practical/Field work/Project work/other activities





85% students strongly agreed that the curriculum is skill based but 11% students seek modification in the present curriculum. They suggested that more certificate and diploma courses must be introduced.







Regarding delivery of content, 97% students strongly agreed about it while 3% showed different opinion and expect more methods of content delivery for increased effectiveness.







The feedback of the students reveals that 96% believe that they are satisfied with the resources available in the college while some differ from rest and believe that resources need to be increased.





93% of the students are satisfied with the availability of the different programs in different streams but 7% believes that more courses should be introduced specially those courses which are in demand now.





About academic atmosphere, 97% of students are happy and satisfied with the curriculum, classes, teachers and all the available facilities while 3% don't strongly agree.
