At present, Dr. CP Dubey Ma'am is the General Secretary of Laghu Udyog Bharti in the state and also the Chairman of the Board of Studies of Technical University.

आज दिनांक 11.3.24 को महाविद्यालय के राधा कृष्णन हाल में महाविद्यालय के गणित विभाग द्वारा अंतर्राष्ट्रीय महिला दिवस का रंगारंग आयोजन किया गया। विभाग की आयोजन सचिव डॉ. प्राची सिंह ने बताया कि कार्यक्रम का प्रारंभ एम.एस.सी गणित की छात्राओं लीना देशमुख और अफरा खान के संचालन में प्रारंभ हुआ। परंपरागत सरस्वती पूजा और वंदना से शुरूआत के साथ अतिथियों का स्वागत नारियल और पुष्प गुच्छ से किया गया। डॉ. प्राची सिंह ने मुख्य अतिथि डॉ. सीपी दुबे का परिचय देते हुए बताया कि डॉ. सीपी दुबे विवेकानंद तकनीकी विश्वविद्यालय, भिलाई की प्रथम डीन होने के साथ-साथ प्रदेश में लघु उद्योग भारती की महामंत्री हैं। कई किताबें लिखने बहुत से देशों में व्यक्तव्य देने और 5 लोगों को पी.एच.डी करवाने के बाद उन्होंने साखी ब्रांड की स्वयं की कंपनी की शुरूआत की जिसमें छोटे बच्चों के कपड़े बी.एस.एफ और सीआरपीएफ बटालियन के यूनिफॉर्म की सिलाई की जाती है। इस संस्थान की मुख्य विशेषता यह है कि इसमें केवल महिलाएं कार्यरत हैं। मुख्य अतिथि डॉ. सीपी. दुबे ने अपने व्यक्तव्य में आत्म विश्वास पर जोर देते हुए कहा कि सबसे पहले सभी के साथ-साथ अपना भी सम्मान करना सीखिए। संकल्प लीजिए उसे पूरा कीजिए और अपना आत्मविश्वास जगाइए। छोटे से छोटे काम करके आत्म निर्भर बनिंए। कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता करते हुए विभागाध्यक्ष डॉ. पद्मावती ने परिवार को जोर देते हुए अपने अहंकार को नियंत्रण में रखने की प्रेरणा दी। स्वाभिमान अश्वय है लेकिन यह अभिमान न बनने पाए। विद्यार्थियों के लिए अंतर्राष्ट्रीय दिवस के शीर्षक "महिलाओं में निवेश करें" प्रगति में तेजी लायें पर एक पोस्टर प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन किया गया जिसमें 15 विद्यार्थियों ने भाग लिया और अपने पोस्टर को प्रस्तुति दी। महिलाओं पर स्वरचित कविता प्रतियोगिता कार्यक्रम की दूसरी प्रतियोगिता थी। इसमें छात्राओं के अतिरिक्त छात्रों ने भी बढ़चढ़ कर हिस्सा लिया और दिल छू लेने वाली कवितायें सुनाई। तीसरी प्रतियोगिता के रूप में इतिहास में चर्चित महिलाओं पर एक प्रश्नोत्तरी कार्यक्रम था, जिसमें भाग लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों को एक सीमित समय में प्रश्नों का उत्तर देना था। यह प्रतियोगिता ऑनलाइन आयोजित की गई थी। इस कार्यक्रम का मुख्य आकर्षण विशेष पहनावा प्रतियोगिता थी जिसमें प्रतिभागियों ने चर्चित महिलाओं के हनावे में आकर उनसे संबंधित भावनाओं को शब्दों में प्रस्तुत किया। किसी ने ज्योतिबा फूल, सुचेता कृपलानी, महामहिम द्रोपदी मुर्मू, रानी लक्ष्मीबाई, गुंजन सक्सेना का रूप धरा तो 7 विद्यार्थियों ने मंगल मिशन में शामिल वैज्ञानिकों की भूमिका निभाई। इस रंग बिरंगे कार्यक्रम ने खचाखच भरे हाल में खूब वाहवाही लूटी। कार्यक्रम के अंत में सभी का धन्यवाद ज्ञापन करते हुए आयोजन सचिव ने छात्राओं को जीवन में सुरक्षा को प्रथम स्थान पर रखने की अनुशंसा की। जब तक हम सुरक्षित हैं तभी हम हर सफलता को हासिल कर सकते हैं। सफलता का एक और सूत्र स्वास्थ्य है, जिसके लिए अपने जीवन में स्वअनुशासन की आवश्यकता है प्रकृति के नियमों के अनुसार जीवन चर्चा ही स्वास्थ्य की कुंजी है। विद्यार्थी
