2. Extension Activities

Objective : To know the ground level reality and awareness generation.

Importance : Awareness programme training as well as how to deliver counseling in rural area.

Activity No. 1. On 24-02-25, 45 Students of Anthropology Department went to Govt. Middle School and High School, Latabor District Balod to convey information about New Education Policy. The school students were motivated to come forward for higher education. They were also told about Anthropology subject and its job perspectives.

After this, students visited Karkabhat village, a Megalithic site in Balod district as a part of their syllabus. Importance of Living Megaliths and the preservation and conservation of Archaeological sites were explained.

Lastly students went to Ganga Maiyya Mandir, Jhalmala, District Balod to know about Tourism Anthropology. They came to know about how being a religious centre , this place acts as a source of economy for the local people through tourism.

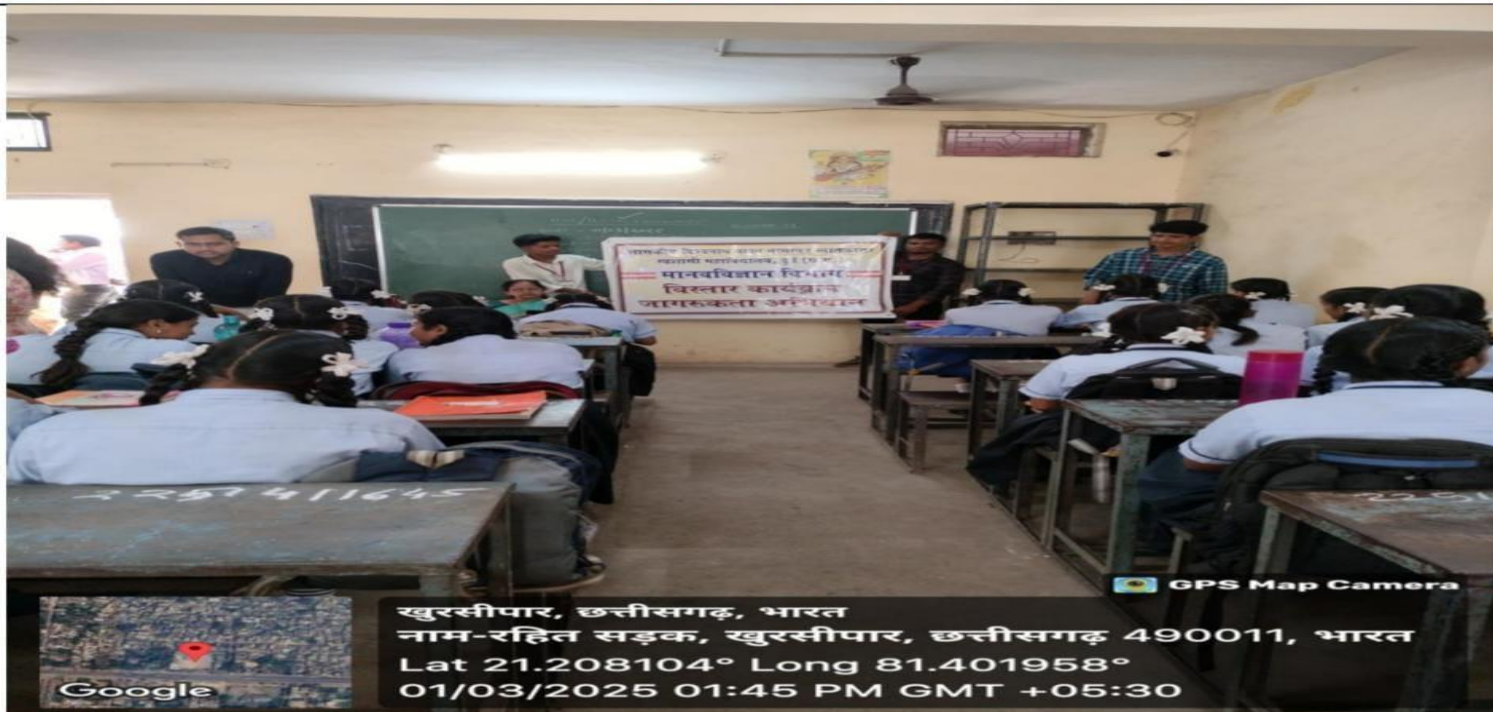

On 1-03-25 , 20 Students went to Swami Atmanand Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru Government High School, New Khursiparm, Bhilai and gave information about New Education Policy, Career Counseling, On-line study material, higher education and so on. Impact of Social media, Importance of Sports Blood Group, DNA, Fingerprinting , Health etc. were also explained to the school students.

In order to get in depth knowledge about the Museum and live experience of Museum students were taken to Mahant Ghasidas Museum, Raipur. Practical knowledge was gained like preservation and conservation techniques of Museum objects, Life ways of various tribes of Chhattisgarh, Ornaments, tools, Musical instruments, art and culture, etc was gained by the students.





3. Career Counseling :

On 17-03-25, Vaid Nirmal Kumar Awasthi, Director, Paramparagat Gyan Ewam Vanoushadhi Vikas Foundation, Bilaspur who is also a Secretary of Traditional Healer Association of Chhattisgarh gave a lecture on “Traditional Knowledge System and Documentation of Medicinal Plants”. Also he explained how easily the career can be started by selling this herbs. He also motivated the students for employment generation through these herbs.

Vaid Samelal Yadav, Vaid Awadhesh Kashyap and Mamta Bage demonstrated the various herbs along with their importance like Makartendu (Asthma, T.B.), Hinglaj (Chickenpox), Dhambater (Worm), Chatamashi (Pain reliever), Anantmool (Skin problem)
