The particulars of its organization, function and duties of the organization

The government V.Y.T.PG. Autonomous College, Durg is strictly following RIGHT OF INFORMATION ACT, 2005 (Act no. 22 of 2005) and executing all responsibilities and duties granted by the RTI Act 2005 in general and section 4 (1) B, in particular.

(A) Particulars of Organization –

The College is purely Government Organization of State of Chhattisgarh, governed by Department of Higher Education, Collegiate Branch, Ministry of Higher Education, Government of Chhattisgarh, and by the act of Hemchand Yadav Vishwavidyalaya, Durg, and Chhattisgarh. We are only NAAC A+ accredited College in the state, besides, College with potential of Excellence (Phase-III) granted by UGC; Centre of Excellence in Science, declared by State Government. We are only college in the state having experience to run Star College Programme of Dept. of Biotechnology, Government of India. Our College catering nearly 7000 students of Arts, Science and Commerce faculties from every corner of States including urban, suburban and tribal area. We have **-23 undergraduates** and 18 Post Graduate Departments and our **16-PG departments** are recognized research centre for Ph.D. program with **57 recognized research supervisor and 302 registered students for Ph.D.** Our College is registered under section 2(f) and 12 (B) and has been granted Autonomous status by University Grant Commission, New Delhi.
